

Construction of solar power generation system for Vatican communication base

Pope Francis has ordered the construction of a solar power plant to supply the Vatican's electricity needs. He did so with the apostolic letter in the form of Motu proprio *Fratello Sole*, published in Italian on May 26, . In line with the principles of the encyclical *Laudato Si'* and a United Nations agreement on climate change, Pope Francis is making the Vatican "greener."
