How do I Turn Off the alarm? Break through the label with a screwdriver. Turn the screw to the "OFF" location. This will deactivate the alarm, stop the low battery chirp, and render the alarm safe for disposal by draining the battery. ****NOTE:**** Turning off the alarm is permanent. How do I remove the alarm from the mounting plate? Remove the alarm from the mounting plate by rotating it in the direction indicated by the arrows on the cover of the alarm. This will deactivate the alarm, stop the low battery chirp, and render the alarm safe for disposal by draining the battery. Why does my alarm keep throwing a low-battery alert? So that means when your acid-sealed lead battery in your alarm cabinet is low or drained or potentially just lost AC power, and it drained the battery level a little bit, it's going to give you a low-battery alert. Now, until that battery is fully charged, it's going to keep throwing that error. How do I bypass a closed alarm system? To bypass an open system you must close it and to bypass a closed system you simply open it. Zone one is usually the entry zone. This is the only zone that has a delay to give you time to get to the panel and deactivate the alarm on a legal entry. It's usually a mercury switch, the plastic block on the door, the block on the frame is a magnet. How long does it take to clear a low battery code? Keep in mind that if your battery is properly connected to your system, it will typically take about an hour or so before the system recognizes that the battery is properly charged so that you can clear the low battery code by inputting your alarm code twice into the keypad. Once activated, the battery will supply power to the alarm for its entire lifespan (10 years) under normal conditions. Align the alarm with the mounting plate. Most systems will begin beeping or chirping as a result of a total power outage or failure to recharge the system backup battery.
