[Photo by Guo Shining/For China Daily] China aims to build over 4.5 million 5G base stations next year and give more policy as well as financial support to foster industries that can define the next decade, the country's top industry regulator said on Friday. How many 5G base stations does Huawei have? The contracts have been split into two projects, with the first covering 63,800 base stations using 2.6GHz to 4.9GHz spectrum, while the second covers 23,141 in the 700MHz band. Huawei is estimated to have secured 45,426 5G base stations worth an estimated 4.1 billion yuan (US\$574 million). Where are 5G base stations located in China?
