Following a public consultation launched in July , the Polish Ministry of Climate and Environment has finalized its energy storage subsidy program which aims to support the deployment of more than 5 GWh of energy storage in the country. The new regulation was published in the Journal of Laws of the Republic of Poland on March 7. When will the energy storage scheme be launched in Poland? Call for applications under the Scheme "Energy storage facilities and related infrastructure for improving the stability of the Polish electricity grid" will be launched already this year. Subsidy contracts are to be entered into by the end of , while the period for spending the funds ends with . What is Poland's energy storage program? The program , "Electricity storage facilities and infrastructure for improving the stability of the Polish power grid," is aimed at companies planning to invest in energy storage facilities with a capacity of at least 2 MW and a minimum capacity of 4 MWh.
