What type of plugs does Slovakia use? Slovakia uses power outlets and plugs of types C & E. Also, the voltage in Slovakia is the same as in Europe. What Outlet does Slovakia Use? Type C plug sockets are used in Europe, Africa and Asia. They have two round pins and no grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 220-240V. This outlet is rated for 2.5 amps. Can a Type C outlet be installed in Slovakia? However, it is not permitted to install type C nor type F wall outlets in Slovakia. But why is that? Typically, type C plug sockets are not allowed to be installed in Slovakia: these outlets are not earthed and are therefore considered dangerous. Only type E power points are permitted because they are grounded and therefore significantly safer.
