Who is responsible for electricity storage in Morocco? Electricity storage in Morocco falls within the scope of competence of the Ministry of Energy, Mines, Water and Environment. ONEE is in charge of the production, the transmission and the distribution of electricity. How is energy storage defined in Morocco?
